

Introduction

1. The Applicant is a Resident Auditor in the Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS). He serves at the P-4 level, and is based in Bamako, Mali.

The Applications

2. At the time of the Applications, the Applicant was the OIOS Chief Resident Auditor at the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq (UNAMI).

3. On 1 December 2015, the Applicant filed an Application (UNDT/NBI/2015/177) contending that the Respondent's decision, following the outcome of the investigation of his allegations pursuant to ST/SGB/2008/5 (Prohibition of Discrimination, Harassment, including Sexual Harassment and Abuse of Authority), was flawed in that it failed to grant him an effective remedy for the harm caused to him, and that the administration failed to provide him with a prompt and efficient internal means of redress. He also alleged that there were other procedural irregularities.

4. On 7 December 2015, the Applicant filed another Application, (UNDT/NBI/2015/179) also relating to the outcome of his complaint challenging the alleged procedural impropriety of the Respondent's actions but referring to particular matters, including failures to deal promptly with certain issues relating to Ms. Yasin,
