

Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former investigator, at the ~~4~~ level, with the Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS) Nairobi.
2. On 24 March 2017, he filed the current application for suspension of action challenging the contents of a letter dated 15 March 2017 which he was informed that since he had resigned from the Organization at a time when a matter involving his alleged misconduct had not been resolved, not

6. The documentary evidence exhibited by the Respondent in support of his reply shows that the Applicant received a response to his management evaluation request on 2 March 2017.

7. The Tribunal may only order suspension of a contested decision under art 2.2 of the UNDT Statute where management evaluation is pending. In the present case, management evaluation has been completed and the response of the MEU communicated to the Applicant.

8. In these circumstances, the application for a suspension of action under art. 13.1 of the Rules of Procedure has been effectively discharged by the said completion of management evaluation and the communication of its outcome to the Applicant.

Orders

9. The Tribunal accordingly strikes out the matter of *Ugaine v. The Secretary-General of the United Nations*, Case No. UNDT/NBI/2017/026.

10. The Applicant's request for anonymity in this application is hereby refused.
