



## Introduction

1. On 6 October 2017, the Applicant, a GS-3 Store Assistant with the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL), filed an application challenging the decision to recover monies from his salary.

2. The deadline for the Respondent's reply was on 8 November 2017.

3. On 7 November 2017, the parties moved the Tribunal to suspend proceedings until 8 December 2017 on the ground that, in the context of the management evaluation process, the Applicant and the Administration were in good faith discussions with a view to informally resolving the dispute.

4. On 8 November 2017, the Tribunal issued Order No. 210 (NBI/2017) suspending proceedings until 15 January 2018.

5. On 6 December 2017, the parties filed another joint motion requesting the Tribunal to further suspend proceedings and extend the deadline for filing of the Respondent's reply until 15 January 2018 which was granted pursuant to Order No. 210 (NBI/2017).

6. On 9 February 2018, Counsel acting on behalf of the Applicant notified the Tribunal of his intention to withdraw the present application following the signing of a settlement agreement between the parties.

## ORDER

7. The Tribunal **ORDERED** that the matter of *Zubah v. Secretary-General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2017/090) be dismissed with costs.
