**Deliberation**

3. When submitting documents through the eFiling portal, parties have the option of requesting that the submission be treated as an *ex parte* filing or that the filing be made under seal. The final decision as to whether the submission is to be treated as an *ex parte* or under seal filing is reserved for the Dispute Tribunal. In the context of the Dispute Tribunal, filing a document *ex parte* means that non-filing
