Introduction

1. The Applicant is a Political Affairs Officer athe P-4 level, working with the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilisation Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA)¹

2. On 16 August 2019 the Applicant filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal contesting the decision to permanently withdraw his MINUSCA driver's permit².

3. The deadline for the Respondent to file a reply is 20 September 2019.

4. On 17 September 2019, the partie billed a joint motion informing the Tribunal that in the context of the management evaluation proceeds, are currently engaged in good faithdiscussions with a view to informally resolving the matter cordingly, the parties are requesting for suspension of proceeding and the extension of the deadline for the Respondent to file reply until 4 October 2019 ending settlement negotiations³.
