Introduction

1. On 7 May 2017, the Applicant, a former staff member working with United Nations African Union Hybrid Operation in Darfur (UNAMID) filed an application before the Dispute Tribunal testing several decisions, including one on the placement of adverse material in his official status file.
2. Pursuant to art. 9.1 of the UNDT Statute and to art. 18.2 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal issued Order no. 220 (NBI/2019), directing the parties to file further submissions and to address legal arguments pertinent to the applicability of ST/AI/292, where a note is placed in personnel file after the staff member has separated from the service of the Organization.
3. The Respondent submitted his response to Order no. 220 (NBI/2019) on 23 December 2019, with the Applicant submitting his response on 24 December 2019.
4. The Tribunal, after careful review of the case record, has decided to summarily dispose of this matter without an oral hearing. In light of the foregoing, the Tribunal, in accordance with art. 19 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure, considers the parties should be given an opportunity to submit any additional information or documents that may assist in the consideration of this matter on the papers.

ORDERS

5. The parties shall file additional information or documents, if any, by Friday, 3 January 2020.
6. Judgment in the matter of *Micaletti v. the Secretary General of the United Nations* shall be delivered on 4 January 2020.
