Introduction

The Applicant a staff member of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the CentAddican Republic ("MINUSCA"), filed an application on 26 December 2019 seeking suspension of the decision not to renew his appointment beyond 1 January 20/20 ontested Decision.")The Applicant also requests: (i) suspension of the contested decisioningend art. 13 suspension of action proceedingpursuantto articles 19 and 36 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure; and (ii) a referral for accountability against the MINUSCA Di521.52 Tm (r)-7()49(a)3(c)3(c)3(o)-20(5. In the instant case, there is administrative decision subjeof an ongoing management evaluation because on 27 December 2019, the Applicant received the outcome of his 26 December 2019 request for management evaluation of the contested decision.

6. The Respondent further contends thetate to a typo on the Applicant's extension of appointment personnel action A("), the contract expiry date reads 1 January 2020 instead of 31 January 2020. As a corrective action, the Organization has raised a new PA, which indicates 31 January 2020 asextpication date of the Applicant's appointment.

Furthermoreit is noted from the application and confirmed by the Respondent that there is no administrative cision not to renew Applicant's appointment beyond
January 2020' as alleged by the Applicant

Considerations
