Introduction and Procedural History

1. The Applicant is the Chief Resident Auditor, with the Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS) at the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo serves on a fixed-term appointment at the P-5 level.
