## Introduction

1. On 10 February 2020, the Applicant, a former Political Affairs Officethæt P-4, step 9 level, working with the United Nations Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara ("MUNURSO") in Laayoune, filed an application before the Dispute Tribunal.<sup>1</sup> He contests a disciplinary measure of separation from service, with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indem<sup>2</sup>nity.

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 28 February 2020.

3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to a hold case management discussion ("CMD"). The purpose of the CMD is to establish the disputed facts ant the need for adducing evidence in light of the reply.
