

Introduction

1. On 10 February 2020, the Applicant, a former Political Affairs Officetheat P-4, step 9 level, working with the United Nations Mission for the Reference in the Western Saharan Laayoune, filed an application before the Dispute Tribundee contests a displinary measure of separation from service, with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indemnit following charges of submitting false financial claims²

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 28 February 2020.

3. The Tribunal notes that application and relies claimed do not extend over the decision on deduction so wever, both the Applicant and the Respondent admit that among them were egitimate expenses incurred by the Application specifically, the Applicant, in his response to the egitations, at para. 10, expressly states that "I indicated in a table form against the amoundaimed, amountspent and the proof referenced and ttached.

6. The Applicant shallalso clearly state the amounts that he received and which he acknowledges that he as not entitled to ant thus were rightly recovered by the Organization

7. The Respondent shall state whether any of the Applicant's expenses those indicated by the Applicantwould have been accepted as proven and reimbursable if properly and timely claimed.

8. The Applicant shallprovide the information required in paragraphs and 6 by 7 January 2021. Failure to comply with the Ordervill result in a rejection of any expense claimed a begit imate beyond what is presently acknowledged by the Respondent. The Respondent will file his response thin 10 days from the Applicant's filing.
