## ORDER GIVING AN OPPORTUNITY TO THE APPLICANT TO RESPOND TO THE RESPONDENT'S REPLY

## Introduction

1. The Applicant is an Acquisition PlanninAgssistant at the FS level, working with the United Nations Mission in South Sud(#dNMISS"), based in Juba.

2. By an application filedon 23 December 2020, the Applicant is contesting a decision to not select him for the position of Requisitions Offizeervertised through Job opening JO# 136259By the same application, the Applicant also challenges the decisions (i) not to select him for the Temporary Job Opening No. 956166 FS Requisitions Officer ("TJO") (ii) to extend the temporary assignment of HH (anonymized for confidentiality)and (iii) to place HH on the roster of pageproved candidates for FS Requisitions Office<sup>7</sup>.

3. The Respondent filed a reply on 28 January 2020 thich it is argued that the contested decision was lawfulle Responden however, avers that the Applicant's claim relating to the decision to not select him for TJO is not receivable me materiae because he did not request management evaluation of that decision as required by staff rule 11.2(c). The challenge relating to the temporary assignment of HH and the decision to roster her among the preved candidates are not receivable atione persona and ratione materiae. The two decisions do not relate to the Applicant's erms of employment and are thus not receivable ratione personae. Secondly, the two decisions are not receivable management evaluation for them.

## ORDER

4. On or before 3.00 p.m. d**M**onday, 27 September2021, the Applicant shall file a response to the reply specifically on the issue of receivability, as argued by the Respondent, and which shall not exceed five pages.
