Introduction

1. On 10 February 2020, the Applicant, a former Political Affairs Officer, at the P-4, step 9 level, working with the United Nations Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara in Laayoune, filed an application before the Dispute Tribunal.¹ He contests a disciplinary measure of separation from service, with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indemnity.²

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 28 February 2020.

3. During a case management discussion held on 16 November 2020, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that he intends to call only one witness whereas the Respondent will not call any witnesses.
