

UNITED NATIONS DISPUTE TRIBUNAL

Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former Chief Procurement Officer at the P-5 level with the African Union/United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur D . He contests the decision to deny his claim for Appendix D benefits.

2. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal held a case management the issues and further evidence to be presented.

Case management

3. Pursuant to art. 19 of its Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal may at any time issue an order or give any direction which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of a case and to do justice to the parties.

Recalling that the General Assembly has consistently encouraged alternative dispute resolution, the Tribunal finds it also appropriate to encourage the parties to explore the possibility of having the dispute between them resolved without recourse to further litigation.
