## **Introduction**

1. On 30 June 2022, the Applicant, filed an application requesting urgent relief under art. 2.2 of the [redacted] and art. 13 of its Rules of Procedure seeking to suspend, pending management evaluation, the decision to not renew his appointment.

2. Together with the application for suspension of action, the Applicant also filed a motion for suspension of the contested decision during the pendency of the Tribunal's consideration of this application (a so-called *Villamorán*-type request).

3. By regular email of 30 June 2022, the Registry acknowledged receipt of the application. The undersigned Judge, as Duty Judge, further informed the parties that the motion for interim suspension was granted, and the present Order is issued to reaffirm this instruction.

## **Consideration**

4. Article 13.3 (Suspension of action during a management evaluation) of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure provides that the Tribunal shall grant an application for interim measures within five working days of the service of the application on the respondent.

7. In order for the Tribunal to seek and consider the Respondent's reply to the present suspension of action application,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

8. Without prejudice to the Dispute Tribunal decision on the application for suspension of action under art. 2.2 of its Statute and art. 13 of its Rules of Procedure, the Respondent shall not undertake, as from the date and time of service of the present Order, any further steps regarding the contested decision.
