Introduction

1. By Order No. 015 (NY/2023) dated 24 February 2023, the Tribunal, *inter alia*, decided to suspend proceedings in this case health condition improves, and instructed the Applicant to inform the Tribunal when it becomes clear that she is able to return to work.

2. On 17 April 2023, the Respondent filed a motion to have receivability determined as a preliminary matter.

Consideration

3. In his motion, the Respondent argues, *inter alia*, that in line with a recent ruling from UNAT in *O'Brien* 2023-UNAT-1313, the present application is not receivable *ratione materiae*. He claims that the contested decision is not a reviewable administrative decision because it does not have any direct effect on the Applicant, has no external legal effect, or directly or adversely impacts the

Nevertheless, it n only raises a question of law that can be dealt with by Counsel without needing specific instructions from the Applicant. The Tribunal thus considers it appropriate to order the above-mentioned motion.
