## General comments

- x FAO has six Regional Forestry Commissions, covering the whole world. The mandate of these commissions are largely identical and presented below.
- x The response from the commissions contain actions and activities performed by the bodies and their secretariat, which are the FAO Regional Offices
- x The responsedoes not contain activities performed the FAO headquarters under the Regular Programme or as part of Regional or Global Projetterefore cannot be considered as a full account of FAO activities in support of the Global Forest Goals. It can however provide a good overview of key activities erformed under the aegis of the Regional Forestry Commissions.
- x The responses provide information on both the actions taken by the Regional Forestry & RPPLVVLRQV DV ZHOO DV WKHLU VHFUHWDULDWV LPSOHP
- x The questionnaire quests information according to the Global Forest Goals and the associated targets. It has to be noted however that hardly any action can be linked with one target, most of the cases not even with one goal. In most cases they impact several goalstiphed targets at the same time. Whenever possible, references were made to other goals and targets but multiple listrW
- x The same applies to clustering the actions according to te predefined categories, they often cover more than on eategory.
- x Policy and legislative actions taken by all commissions are provided separately in these introductory remarks.
- x For obvious reasons the responses place more emphasis on completed and ongoing activities than on new or planned ones, to avoid a **xtee**sive and complex document, whi**w** buld be very hard to interpret
- x The questionnaire leaves room for interpretation and therefore some conceptual differences may occur between the responses from the different regions. It is propos**tructliff**erences
