- 1. The format is largely narrative, reflecting the qualitative nature of the majority of targets. It builds on and further simplifies the UNFF11 reporting format and is structured around the newly adopted Global Forest Goals (GFGs) and targets of the UNSPF.
- 2. Member States are asked to submit only information that is not currently provided to CPF member organizations, or that is unavailable in other international databases, as to the extent possible, the information submitted by countries to the UNFFS will be supplemented
