Malaysia take notes on the progress made in the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity (UNCBD), United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and the recent World Forestry Congress (WFC). It is our view that each of these platform has its own objectives and purposes.
