1. Durable solutions

- x It is Statesprimary responsibility to take the lead the prevention of internal displacement where possible as well asprotecting and finding durable solutions for IDPs that national and local levels. The international community should play a role that supports and complements the actions of the national authoritiels rough, for example, humanitarian assistance, evelopment assistance, addressing root causes of internal displacement including peacebuilding capacity building and innovative forms of financial supposor IDPs and their host communities.

3. Financing

- x In the spirit of the Grand Bargaint is key to ensure multiyear and flexible financint organizations who protected assist those affected by humanitarian essis including IDPs and their host communities
- x In addition, KNL greatly encourages finding alternative and innovative ways of financing for IDPs, and would specifically welcome medinvolvement and investment of IP and the private sector
- x Building on the experiences with existing pooled funding mechanisms (CBPFs, CERF and Peace Building Fund) in delivering impact, improving coordination and enhancing a localized response, a possible avenue to explore is setting up a pooled funding mechanism focused on durable solutions for IDPs at country level. At the same time purposes of coordination and coherence we should be cautious to create new additional funding channels. Threrefo the possible consideration of multiartner trust funds for specific IDP situations should go hand in hand with the investigation of merging funds.

4. Data

x In order to advocate for rights and needs of IDDstake evidence based decisions regarding interventions and to strengthen accountabilithere is a need for reliable data, analysis, and examples of good practice Many different organizations and initiatives collect æmdalyze data, and make them accessible or reasons of efficiency as well effectiveness there is a need to aligndate systems and for closer collaboration between these organizations dinitiatives KNL would welcome recommendations of the HLP on how existing data initiatives can ensure coordination and complementarity on IDP-related where we provide datasets or access to them where these alæcking and what actions are needed in order to further strengthen the evidence base flot Pinterventions.
