





6. The sole effect of the Tribunal's decision is the determination and finding of article 2.1(a) and article 6.1(a) of the Statute, . . .

2.1. The Director's decision is a "sole prerogative" and is a judgment on a "discretionary matter", as indicated for article 6, paragraph 1, of the present statute, against the "Geneva Convention" as the Chief Administrative Officer of the United Nations.

(a) To allow an administrative decision to be appealed to the non-Sole Arbitrator in the terms of a commitment of the Secretary-General.

6.1 An appeal against article 2, paragraph 1, of the present statute may be filed . . .

(a) Any staff member of the United Nations, including the United Nations Secretary-General's administrative staff and employees.

A. The Tribunal notes that the Applicant is a staff member of the United Nations Secretariat, as well as the United Nations and employees, and that she does not contest an administrative decision taken by the Secretary-General of the United Nations (UN), as the Chief Administrative Officer of the UN.
