Antigua and Barbuda

Antigua and Barbuda is a dual-island nation located in Lesser Antilles of the Eastern Caribbean Sea. Antigua is the larger of the two islands, covering 108 square miles. Barbuda 62 square miles. Home to the 1,600 in Barbuda.
