

Mr. Gilberto DF António is the Senior Advisor to the Secretary-General of the Secretariat of the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA).

Previously, he worked at the Permanent Mission of Angola to the World Trade Organization (WTO), actively participating in multilateral trade negotiations. He was the focal point of the African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States at the WTO on regional integration issues.

António also worked as a consultant to the Trade representatives at the Geneva Business School. He has spoken at workshops on trade policy and negotiations, as well as on trade facilitation organizations at the WTO and UNCTAD.

He studied Political Science and Economics, at the University of Geneva, and the University of Neuchâtel, both in Switzerland. He has also obtained several certificates in Trade, Investment and Diplomacy from international institutions, including the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR), UNCTAD, WTO, and the World Bank.

His research domain is international trade and investment. He is the author of several books, as well as articles/working papers on international trade and investment.
