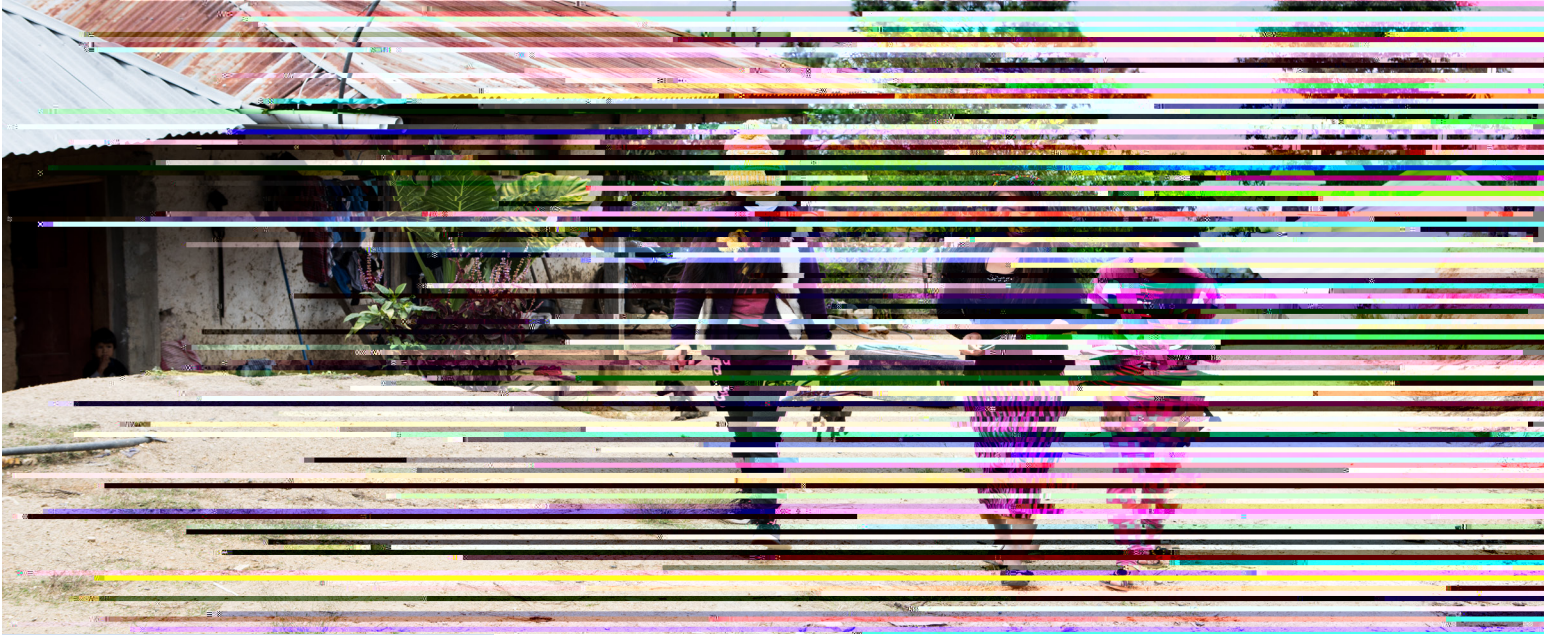


The Secretary-General's Peacebuilding Fund

Promotion of respect for human rights and sustainable development has been at the core of the Peacebuilding Fund's approach to post-conflict recovery and preventing new social conflicts in Guatemala, and this cross-pillar approach is explicitly reflected in the current Strategic Results Framework. PBF currently also works to incorporate the humanitarian-development-peace triple nexus to its programming, including by recognizing that ending hunger, enabling development and resolving land conflicts as inter-related and mutually reinforcing goals which demand integrated responses.

The UN Secretary-General's Peacebuilding Fund is the organization's financial instrument of first resort to sustain peace in countries or situations at risk or affected by violent conflict. The Fund works in concert with UN entities, governments, regional organizations, multilateral banks, national multi-donor trust funds or civil society organizations.

The Fund works across pillars and supports integrated UN responses to fill critical gaps; respond quickly and with flexibility to peacebuilding opportunities; and catalyze processes and resources in a more tolerant fashion.
