The First CSO-UN Dialogue on Peacebuilding – Executive Summary

The inaugural two-day Civil Society Organisation (CSO)-UN Dialogue on Peacebuilding took place at the UN Headquarters in New York from November 30 to December 1, 2023. It aimed to provide a platform for UN entities and civil society actors dedicated to peacebuilding to engage in substantive discussions on global peacebuilding efforts. The event strived to systematise an ongoing dialogue within the larger context of the New Agenda for Peace between the UN and civil society and set the

The dialogue underscored several Strengthening the CSO-UN partnership emerged as the central priority, emphasising the need for strategic partnerships and equal two-way engagement between the UN and civil society and line involvement of women and youth — was highlighted as essential for unlocking collective action and devising effective peacebuilding approaches.
