THE WORK OF WOMEN IN PEACEBUILDING NETWORK (WIPNET) OF WEST AFRICA NETWORK FOR PEACEBUILDING (WANEP)

The Wonen in Reachuilding Network (WIPNET) is one of the programmes of the West Africa Network for Reachuilding (WANEP) aimed at integrating a gender pespective in its peacebuilding work

It was laurched in November 2001 with the primary objective to build the capacity of women

8 Perhaps the most innovative initiative is the establishment of in Liberia which is also being replicated in Cote d Ivoire and Siena Leone and is gad ally spreading to Senegal and other countries. The Peace Hit provides a safe space for the empowement of gassicots women while getting some of their issues resolved. The hit is operated by professionals like lavyers, dotors and dirical psychologists who provide proboro services for women and girls survivors of Sexual and Center Based Violence (SGBV). Some of the services provided induce legal representation and following upon cases of rape and defilement in court and making sue that perpetators are drive consided. The Hit also serves as psychotherapy and healing centre for transitized women and girls who are victims and survivors of GBV.

The htt also serves as grants for neating avareness on the rights of vomen and grassicols women who come there to acquire skills such as bead making sewing and other handcasts to get the mecononically empowered in order to enhance their living standards and reduce their vulnerability. In 2019 out of the 163 rape cases recorded, 75 were effectively proceeded. Members of the Peace Huts are regularly trained on Adult Literacy and Numeracy activities including strategies for tacking GBV with emphasis on psychosocial support services. In 2017 a total of 105 women were trained in Liberia on psychosocial support services. In 2017 a total of 105 women were trained in Liberia on psychosocial support and are unerthy providing traina conselling and psychosocial support to survivors and victims of SCBV in their respective counties. Through the Peace Huts facilitated by WANEP in Liberia, the women have been nonitoring SCBV cases to ensure thet victims get speedy justice. As a result, the elies bein a significant increase in the undestanding of SCBV anong community members.

Despite all these efforts there are still some huckes in the way of women's full, equal and meaningful participation in peacebuilding processes which continue to militate against
