



A two-day multi-stakeholder dialogue and capacity-building partnership event (the “Event”), will be held at the United Nations Headquarters from 24 to 25 January 2019.

The Event is being held in accordance with the programme of work for the period 2017-2020 for the second cycle of the Regular Process, endorsed by the General Assembly in its resolution 71/257 of 23 December 2016 on “Oceans and the law of the sea”.



An information fair will be organized as part of the Event, where States, intergovernmental organizations and non-governmental organizations will present their capacity-building activities and partnerships as well as other materials relevant to the Event.
