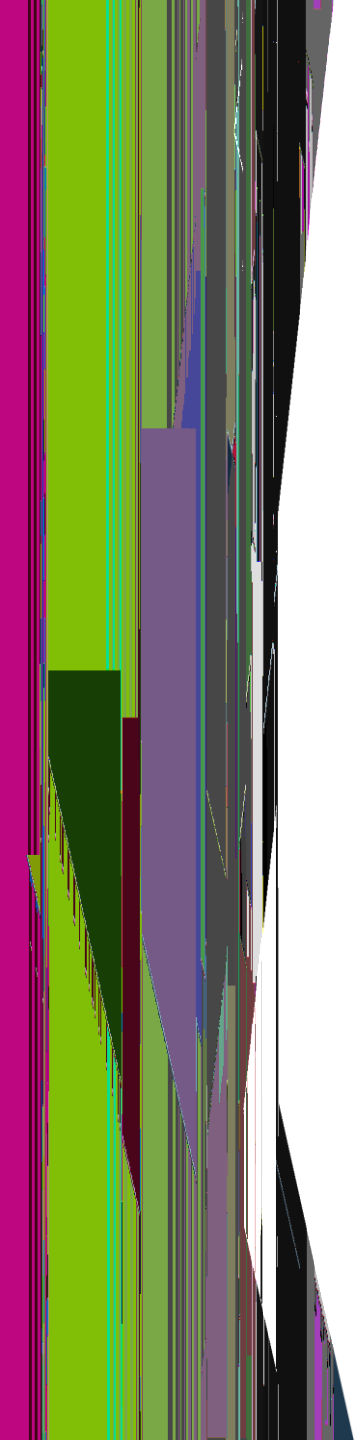


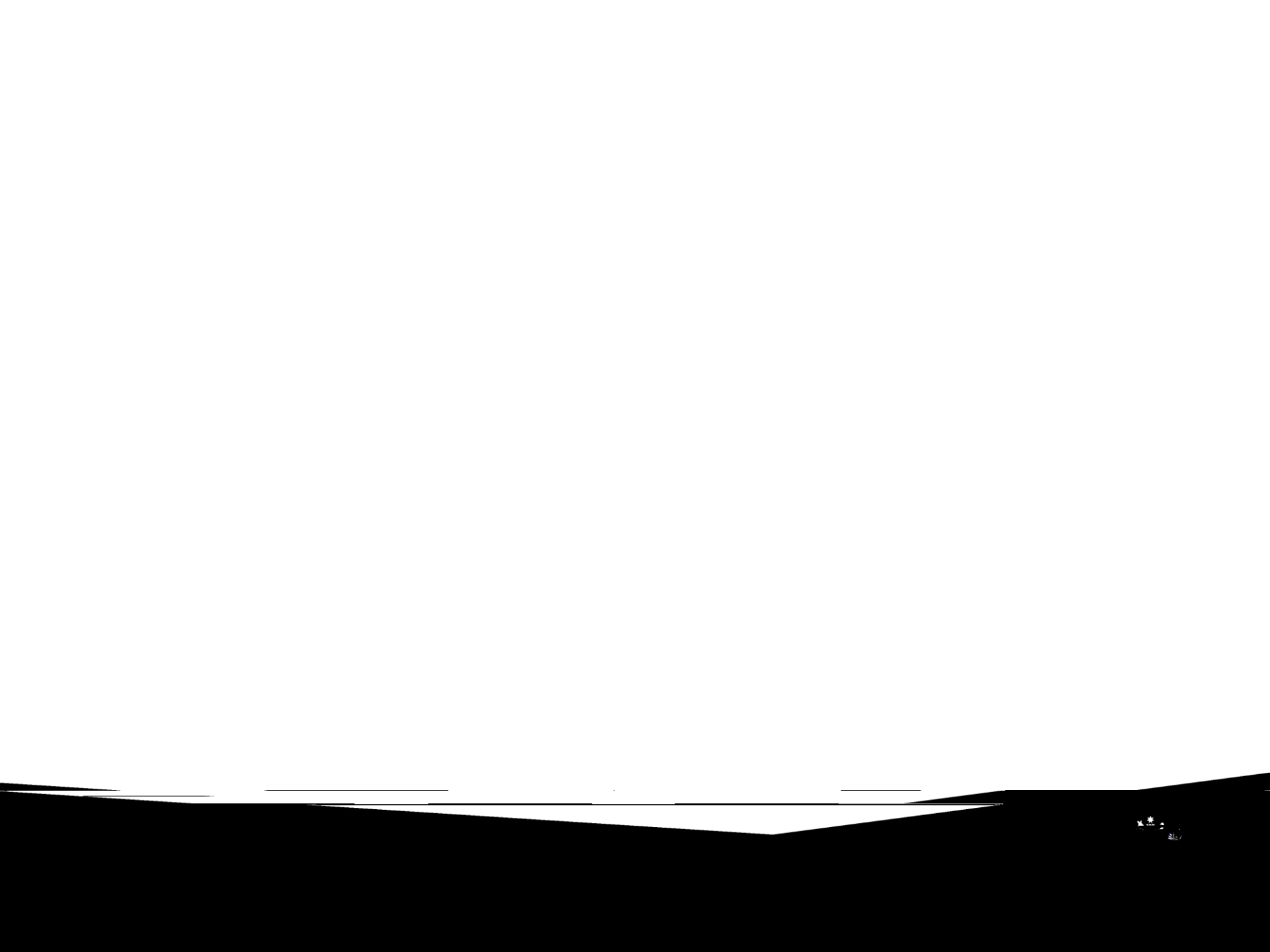
ICT and Terrorism Financing
