- x Agree on a consistent way to use the Rio Markers and an objective grounding to determine what counts as a significant or principal climate focus. Project documentation should be included in data submissions so that others can assess this.
- x Require that both commitments and disbursements to date against those commitments are reported. Proper accounting of climate financing should be based on monies or resources that transferred hands, rather than on committed or pledged funds. This will allow for an accurate picture of the support provided. New pledges should also be accompanied by a delivery plan and a timetable of disbursements.
- x Take steps to clearly define additionality. While there may be crossover between some climate and development objectives (adaptation in particular), the lack of clear identification allows development finance to be redirected away from-slateing programmes.
