- xxi. Statement of the problem: Global challenges resist localized solutions, and an adversarial approach to governance hinders progress. The Security Council's five permanent members, representing only 20% of the world's population, wield veto power over any attempted UN decision. This exclusive group lacks representation from the most populous country on the planet (India) and any country from the continent with the youngest population (Africa). This discriminatory setup undermines the efficiency and legitimacy of the United Nations, hindering the establishment of globally applicable and enforceable rules.
