### Chapter I. Sustainable development and financing for development

1.1 Youth-led Initiatives for Sustainable Development: Encourage the establishment of youth-led initiatives that promote sustainable development, focusing on education, employment, and entrepreneurship. Provide financial support and resources for innovative projects led by young individuals committed to integrity and transparency.

1.2 Integrity in Financial Systems: Advocate for youth involvement in financial decision-making processes to ensure transparency and accountability. The aim is to tailor financial instruments for young, integrity-focused entrepreneurs, bridging gaps in existing financial resources.
