Mr. Chair,
Dear Colleagues,
Ladies and gentlemen,

On behalf of the Government of Azerbaijan Republic I would like to congratulate all of us with the 50th anniversary of the Beijing Platform for Action, which has had a great impact on the raising of women's issues in the world. Celebrating this anniversary we must recall the names of those women who played an important role in the struggle for women's rights. Azerbaijan was one of the first who accepted ethical, moral and as example institutional machinery and mechanisms for the advancement of women were created. We have showed strong support and commitment to the Beijing Platform for Action. By creating various programs aimed at the achieving gender equality and women's empowerment. New legislations have been adopted and introduced within this period. After the adoption of the Law on the political rights of state guarantees of gender equality, all relevant amendments were made to other legislative acts in accordance with the Law.

A gender budgeting system was introduced and this means that the state budgeting system of Azerbaijan has had a direct impact on ensuring gender equality.

There is no such a sphere where our women are not represented now. We have women judges, generals, civil servants, deputies of the parliament, high level state officials and our National Congress. Azerbaijan has various women's programs and conferences of women judges, managers, entrepreneurs and NGOs are organized continually in regions. These events have become very important in demonstrating the role of women in society and in the economy. They also allow creation of intersectoral and networks between the state and non-governmental structures in the sphere of women empowerment and gender equality.

Significant progress has been made in number of areas. For example, we consider the results of the latest elections to the municipality as a achievement. With the support of the civil society in the country and global gender equality efforts, a number of women in municipalities has increased from 4.5% in 2009 and 33% women have been elected to the legislatures.

An enormous work against gender based violence is being conducted in the country. We are adopting Law "On the prevention of domestic violence" which is on the agenda of the Parliament and we are expecting its soonest adoption.

I want to mention specially that despite of global economic crisis none of the social programs was stopped. The special amounts were assigned in the state

budget for social protection of the children, women and families. Azerbaijan government incorporated gender as one of the key elements in the poverty reduction and sustainable development strategies. Various initiatives and access to employment opportunities have been increased.

Government strengthened programs to support women entrepreneurs, providing gender equality in the process of developing special training courses, trainings and access to credit.

I would like to draw your attention to the fate of continuation of the aggression against our state and to the fate of the hundreds of women, children and elderly hostages and prisoners of war, and also to the problems for women refugees and IDPs. Our government continues to give priority attention to this problem and implement targeted measures for the prevention of this problem, ensuring refugees access to the education, employment, health and full integration into society, especially, since this is one of the critical areas of concerns and challenges in implementation of the Beijing Platform for Action.

In conclusion, I would like to commend the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination on the Status of Women for valuable contribution to the process of the gender equality across the world. Every year sessions give member states opportunity to exchange experience and spin-off. It is important to maintain high level of opportunities for women.
