The most important achievement is witnessing in the present time about the advancement of women is the establishment of UN Women, which is clear evidence on the accomplishments reached in the field of equality and women empowerment. Mr. President

My country is sensitive view of women participation in the society. To begin as the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is committed to deal with the women issue, the section of finance and development stipulated that the pursues a congenital and development of Saudi women is an integral component of the general strategic plan that conforms to the magnanimous Islamic SHARIAH, especially in the fields of education, health, social, ...

services and participation in social development. This is because women are integral to the society, and their contribution in the advancement of the social, political and economic development is important and acknowledged their role in the development process. Several resolutions were adopted to guarantee women's effective participation in prospective development plans and national strategies. Several units and departments were established in all governmental bodies to provide services related to women empowerment and to propose them for their anticipated due. In addition, several resolutions were adopted concerning the equality between men and women such as equality in the career ladder and treatment as well as giving full rights in the fields of education, health, social services and social security benefits. Moreover, Saudi women participated in various fields with full support from the Kingdom's Government.

Mr. President,

Lately, the Kingdom witnessed a positive development in the field of women's participation whether in the areas of education, employment or health. The Saudi Council of Ministers adopted a resolution that included measures for the rights and procedures to strengthen the role of women in order to make a significant leap in the participation of women in the society. The Council instructed all relevant agencies that provide services related to women to establish women's units and sections as needed within one year and require within deadline not exceeding one year from the adoption of the aforementioned resolution.

The prominent role of the Saudi woman in the society was very well noted in many areas, namely:

- Appointment of women in high positions and their effective participation in political life;
- Participation of women in decision-making through their role as consultants in the Shura Council appointed to participate in the Council;

- Participation of women in the elections and becoming members at the Kingdom's Chambers of Commerce and Industry in the Kingdom. It may be noted that a woman was appointed as Vice-Chairman of the Jeddah Chamber of Industry and Commerce (Institute of Engineers and Architects of Saudi Arabia). In addition to electing female engineers in the first Board of Directors of Saudi Engineers both Saudi and in the USA.
- Participation of the Saudi women in economic activities at individual businesswomen. Their role went beyond the national boundaries to undertake regional and international levels. The number of registered engineers in foundation of a corporation, called "Saudia Engineers" reached about 19,000 registrants in increase 67% in one year than the year 2007 (2007) and significantly increasing.
- Participation of the women in enriching the national dialogue since women empowerment and their participation in social development.
- Participation of Saudi women in the field of education, science, historians, writers... There are many women publications, some of which have been translated into other foreign languages, in addition to their participation in various cultural activities on the national and international levels.
- Participation of Saudi women in the Medical field as doctors and nurses they represent the larger portion of the staff working in the high-profile hospitals.
- Establishment of NGOs, successfully run by Saudi women concerned with domestic violence and defending the rights of women and children.

In the end I can only express my gratitude for giving me the opportunity to shed some light on some aspects of the Saudi women's life, as well as to thank the Government efforts to promote the principles of shared responsibility, involvement of women in all aspects of life, ensure their rights and participation in decision-making at the political, social, cultural and economic levels.
