This issue of Network also contains updates on a new tool to manage gender-based violence and the designation of the 25th of each month as "Orange Day" to commemorate violence against women.

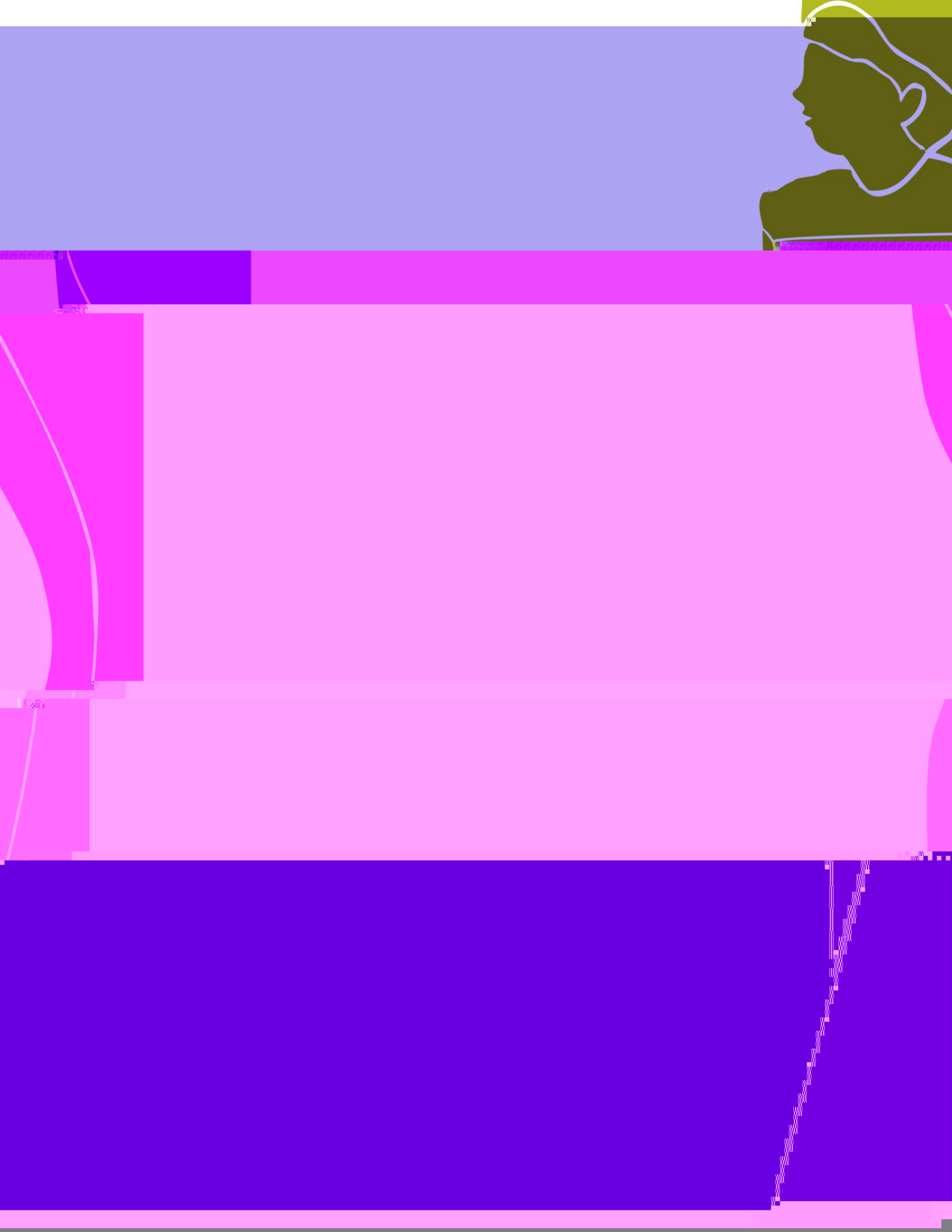
We share these stories in the hope that they will inspire and strengthen all our efforts to advance gender equality and women's empowerment wherever we may be around the world.
